Last month, the 8th cohort of tailoring students successfully completed their training and celebrated with a graduation service, during which they received a certificate and a sewing machine with a table and accessories.



The course lasts six months, and during that time the students practice daily on their sewing machines, learn how to cut patterns, create samples for their display boards and albums. They are taught by a qualified and dedicated tutor who gives personal care and attention to each student. Each day begins with prayer, songs of thanksgiving to God, and Bible readings. Our project partners encourage and guide them through prayer and counsel.



Ten new students have started their training and are already making good progress. They are so thankful for his opportunity and are eagerly learning new skills with great interest and dedication.
